## Leonardo da Vinci Mobility Actions

Mr. Leonardo Pinna gave a presentation explaining details about the different possibilities for applying mobility projects within Leonardo da Vinci actions.

The Mobility Actions support the mobility of three different kinds of participants: Initial vocational education and training (IVT), people in the labour market (PLM) and vocational education and training professionals (VETPRO)

Mainly there are two types of mobility: Transnational placements in enterprises or in training institutions, and Placement and exchanges aimed at the further professional development of trainers and guidance counsellors.



Mr. Pinna also explained the life of a project and the steps to apply for a grant of the mobility program as well as the relevant documents institutions must develop for the application form: Quality Commitment, letters of intent, etc.



## Workshop 3: The future of InnMain

At this point of the project it is necessary to think about the future of our Association. In order to do it, the participants were divided in two groups, teachers and responsible, with the aim of sharing ideas and finding paths to keep working in the future. At the end of the workshop some conclusions were drawn. Here are the most relevant.

**Who are we?** InnMain is a network of educational institutions, companies, chambers of commerce and associations of entrepreneurs in the field of knowledge of Maintenance. **Our mission** is to serve maintenance in Industry with quality education, skills and training. The **teachers** are the main protagonists in InnMain. International departments

will be established as a basis of future work. Also the presence of **companies** is basic to be aware of their needs, to be always at the forefront of technological innovation, and to facilitate international internships. In the next meeting we will draw a Cooperation Agreement. What is clear is that all of us want to give continuity to InnMain.
