One of the objectives established in the constitution of InnMain was trying to participate in programs funded by the European Commission, as a mean of keeping in contact and for developing activities in common.

Apart from the mobility programs aimed at students and teachers, the InnMain partners are now participating in three different Transfer of Innovation Projects (TOI).

Fortunately almost all our institutions are involved in at least one of these projects. This leaflet aims at keeping all the partners informed about what is going on.

Now we are preparing the new scenario, the Erasmus + Program. We need to wait until the call is published, but we know that networks will be the basis on which all the mobility and innovation programs will be developed.

We can say that until now we have been walking in the right direction, as our TOI projects are aligned with the European strategy 2020. The aims of the European Commission are taken into account in all projects: we are working to improve the quality of the mobility programs.

## The Mobility Matrix will allow the validation of learning outcomes between schools

The Top.MoSt Project is now in its second year. The schools participating in this Project are from 6 different countries: Dudley College, Markiezaat, Xabec, Izmit Vocational school, Handwerkskammer Koblenz and Lepido Rocco.

The aim of this Project is to create a "Mobility Handbook" to show what each school has to offer for mobility, and a "Mobility Matrix", which is the tool to prepare high quality mobility programs.

The partners have worked in

groups: International Departments. Via Skype meetings they have agreed upon common learning outcomes that are taught in the different schools.

Now they are working on the description of those learning outcomes, and writing the Learning Agreement – which is based on what they have achieved. ## T.O.I. "One teacher and one student working on ProjectX" (one2one)



The kick-off meeting of this T.O.I. project took place in Kuopio (Finland) on the 6th and 7th of November. The schools participating (from 7 different countries) are ValDorío, Savo, U. of Pitesti, Meram Vocational School, CSC Birmingham Xabec and Lycée I. Newton.

"ProjectX" is a methodological guide for a student to carry



out a concrete activity, one to one with the teacher, in which theory and practice are both perfectly integrated, and which is related to the real workplace.

The aim of this project is two-fold: on one hand to bring closer the needs of the companies and, on the other hand, to improve the pedagogical methodology allowing

teachers to pay attention to each singular student, and concerning about their own personal learning rhythms. The partnership will create 21 ProjectX (tree each school).
