

Relevant topics we have discussed

1. Dudley College encourage us to make a reflection about what is InnMain: we really are a “Network”: this concept opens the vision to a wider perspective. Develop a greater support network – Connecting managers, teachers, employers and students. Create an international hub (sharing of resources, ideas, common concerns, employer strategies etc.)
2. TEC makes a reflection about our perspective. We would like to go deeper into the concept of InnMain as a “knowledge hub”. Partners can take advantage of the know-how that other partners can have, and can share expertise about how to tackle the challenges that we have to face in schools.

3. Creating different tiers of cooperation (one size does not fit all). For example, in the business perspective TEC told us about their experience in India, how they are “provider” of different services: student program, Teacher program, Counselling, Projects, Franchising, Customized programs and activities. All programs are based on a long term relationship and a common/transparent economy.

TEC also offers summer schools: Smart Automation, Innovation – Training, Drones, etc.

4. XABEC explained how they have opened their scope to Latin-America. They also have this “business perspective”.
5. There are some issues that concern us all, such as making maintenance and engineering studies more attractive to young people; the orientation of young people in the choice of career; how to avoid school failure, etc. It is these issues we can share experiences and promote common projects.
6. In all schools we must introduce innovation. One of the most important issues we have to face now in schools is the implementation of Industry 4.0. Izmit School is going to have a FabLab in the school: they can transmit their experience.
7. We realize that we need employer’s engagement. Dudley College has a good experience, we can learn from them. Linking national employers across InnMain network.
8. We need to improve our strategy and our marketing. We need to do self-assessment – carry out a SWOT analysis
